Subject: Next 14C Intcal/Dendrochronology open workshop

After much discussion, we have planned the next IntCal 14C and dendrochronology open workshop on August 19-20, 2017 immediately after the AMS meeting in Ottawa, Canada.

This is your opportunity to present any new or old information which should be considered for inclusion in future International calibrations and how to deal with disparate datasets.

The formal IntCal committee (which will meet earlier in Belfast) will have representatives at this workshop - and we are hopeful that everyone with new annually-based data could send a representative. This would be important for IntCal to consider in future.

The meeting is organized by Alan Hogg, Charlotte Pearson and myself, with assistance from Laim Kieser the Ottawa team.

The AMS-14 organizers have extended the availability of hotel and student accommodation block bookings until Aug. 21.

Please spread this information to your colleagues as needed. The purpose of this email is to inform as many people as possible. We will add this announcement to the AMS-14 and Radiocarbon websites.

Although some indicated they can't attend for various reasons, we believe this is the best time for this workshop. The Arizona Tree-Ring Laboratory is also considering a dendrochronology-oriented workshop later in the year, focused on plant biology and other topics.
